HEY PARENTS! THIS WEEK

- **BIBLE:** Matthew 18:23–35

ASK THIS

Because sometimes you and your kid need a conversation-starter that isn't, "So . . . how was church?"

- **What did the king do for the servant who owed ten thousand bags of gold?**
- **Why can we always forgive?**

HEY KIDS! THIS WEEK'S KINGDOM KIDS ACTIVITIES | APRIL 14th

1. Read this week's Bible story in Matthew 18:23-35 & Discuss the "ASK THIS" questions with a family member.
2. This week's focus is about forgiveness, would you say you are quick to ask for forgiveness when you do something wrong? And do you forgive easily if someone does something wrong to you?
3. Talk to your parent about a time a friend or a family member did something that upset you that you're still mad about. Then take a moment and ask God to show you how you can forgive that person so you can let go of the hurt and anger.
4. Things that help you practice forgiveness are, - Praying - Don't allow comments to bother you - Take deep breaths - Don't say bad things about others. Are you willing to practice these? Write down the practices that you plan to use when showing forgiveness.
5. Draw a picture of a time you had to forgive someone and how it felt. Then write the big idea over the picture, "We Can Always Forgive". Remember Jesus always forgives you and we need to follow Jesus' trend! For 2 extra tokens bring this to HopeCity and show a Kids Team Member.
